Dear future delegate!

Please carefully read the information below to know more about Peru and the Congress before applying.

DEADLINES

Applications are open from March 13th until April 13th, 2024. Applications will open at 08:00 and close at 23:59 local time (UTC-5).

FEE

Delegate fee: €380 with an additional Central Fund Tax of €30 (8% of the fee). So that, the total fee is €410.

Different rates apply for IVSA Officials and Reduced Fee Spots.


VISA

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

Jorge Chavez International Airport

Lima Airport (LIM) is Peru's main International Airport, from which different national and international flights arrive and depart. If you want to know more about it, its restrictions and more, you can visit its website (www.lima-airport.com/).

The OC will take care of your reception at the airport and then transfer you to the hotel. In addition, once the Congress is over, you will also be transported from the hotel to the airport.

ACCOMODATION

LANGUAGE

Spanish is the official language of Peru. About 20% of the population has some proficiency in English, with younger generations being especially likely to speak it fluently.

WEATHER

Lima's weather is expected to be between 12-20 °C with windy conditions, so it is advisable to bring a jacket. No rain is expected.

CURRENCY AND PAYMENTS

Our currency is "Peruvian Sol (S/.)", with presentations in coins and bills.



- **€1 (EUR) = S/. 4.10**
- **\$1 (USD) = S/. 3.70**

We recommend using debit or credit cards (Visa and Mastercard) and cash for transactions in supermarkets, restaurants and shopping centres.

Most places accept payments in cash, so it is highly advisable to carry some. The OC will help you with the currency exchange upon your arrival.

FOOD

Peruvian cuisine stands out for its diversity and richness of flavours, a testament to the blending of cultures and the abundance of native ingredients like corn, potatoes, chilli peppers, and quinoa. Key highlights include soups, stews, and culinary hybrids such as chifa (Chinese-Peruvian) and Nikkei cuisine (Japanese-Peruvian).

All meals will be provided by us, including vegetarian and vegan options, and we will offer some recommendations should you wish to explore additional flavours on your own.

POST-CONGRESS

There are four destinations for the Post-Congress. The fees will vary depending on the destination selected and should be paid together with the Congress fee. Cusco (August 15th-20th)

- Activities: City tour, visit to Machu Picchu and archaeological sites
- Elevation: around 3,400 meters above sea level
- Weather: chilly, dry and windy
- Fee: €520

Iquitos (August 15th-19th)

- Activities: City tour, excursion trips, and visit to an animal sanctuary
- Weather: Sunny, humid and rainy
- Elevation: around 100 meters above sea level
- **Fee: €340**

Puno (August 15th-19th)

- Activities: City tour, visit to Lake Titicaca and archaeological sites
- Weather: Cold, cloudy, and it may snow
- Elevation: around 3,800 meters above sea level
- **Fee: €340**

Tarapoto (August 15th-19th)

- Activities: City tour, visit to Blue Lagoon, waterfalls and excursion trips
- Weather: Sunny, humid and rainy
- Elevation: around 400 meters above sea level
- **Fee: €340**





PUBLIC LAWS

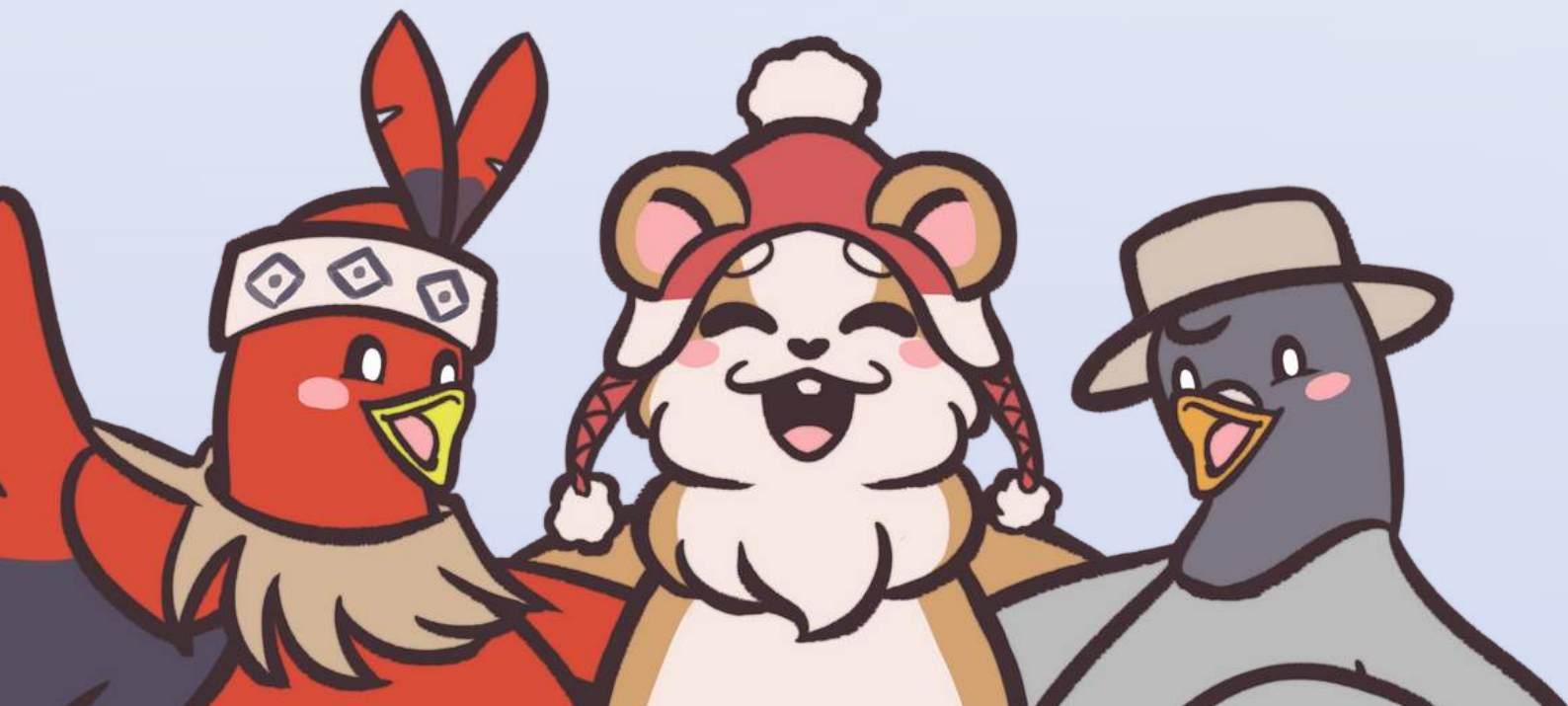
- Only people over 18 years old can smoke in authorised places, so you should check that there is no "No Smoking" sign in the place you are in.
- Only people over 18 years old can buy and drink alcohol. You cannot drink in public spaces.
- Any kind of harassment or discrimination is prohibited and will be punished according to our laws.
